Lectures before and during the camp will include the following: Promise & Law; What is Leadership?; How to be a successful Leader; Roles of a Patrol Leader; Building Character, Patrol System; Base System; Effective Communication; Motivation; Program Planning; Safety Measure; Patrol Leader /Group Council.
2. We strongly encourage your scouts to participate in the above training camp as this is one of the requirements for Scout to be selected as Patrol Leader when they are in Secondary 3 and for the Chief Commissioner Award.
3. All participating schools are required to send their Teacher or Volunteer Adult Leaders during the training. Adult supervision is one of the 7 elements of Scout Method. The ratio of 1:8 (1 Leader/Rover : 8 participating Scouts).

A PATROL OF 8 CAMPERS

1. Dome Tent (If there is Male & female, it will be 2 Tents)
2. First Aid Kit
3. 2 Compasses and 1:50000 Singapore Topo Map
4. 2 Mosquito Coil Holders
5. Firewood for Outdoor Cooking
6. Camp Craft Material (Cloth line, Flagpole, Simple Gateway, Boundary)

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

A. CLOTHES BAG

1. Full Scout Uniform
2. 4 T-shirt (preferably white/School T-shirt/Troop T-shirt)
3. 4 Trousers (preferably black/School Shorts/P.T Shorts)
4. 1 set pyjamas/track suit and pants
5. 4 underclothings
6. 4 pair of socks
7. 1 groundsheet
8. 1 poncho
9. 1 sleeping bag
10. 1 pair of canvas shoe
11. 1 pair of slipper

B. TOILET BAG

1. 1 bath towel
2. 1 face towel
3. 1 toothbrush
4. 1 toothpaste
5. 1 comb
6. 1 bath soap/ shampoo
7. 1 toilet roll
8. Washing powder (Optional)

C. MESS BAG

1. 1 Mess Tin
2. Stainless Fork & Spoon
3. 1 Mug
4. 1 Water bottle

D. ACCESSORIES

1. Sewing kit (Optional)
2. 1 torch light & Extra Battery
3. Personal First Aid Kit (Optional)
4. Personal medicine
5. Writing material (Pen, Ruler, etc)
6. Extra plastic bag

* Note. Use Backpack to contain these stuffs for the Camp. Sling Bag is not encouraged.
