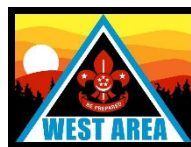

Lectures before and during the camp will include the following: Promise & Law; What is Leadership?; How to be a successful Leader; Roles of a Patrol Leader; Building Character, Patrol System; Base System; Effective Communication; Motivation; Program Planning; Safety Measure; Patrol Leader /Group Council.
2. We strongly encourage your scouts to participate in the above training camp as this is one of the requirements for Scout to be selected as Patrol Leader when they are in Secondary 3 and for the Chief Commissioner Award.
3. All participating schools are required to send their Teacher or Volunteer Adult Leaders during the training. Adult supervision is one of the 7 elements of Scout Method. The ratio of 1:8 (1 Leader/Rover : 8 participating Scouts).
